Challenges:

The project involved working in high density residential areas with the potential to cause major disruptions to highways, residents, and to the general public.

Outcome:

16.2 Kilometres of new PE mains and 761 new services have been delivered, ahead of program and to budget, with minimal disruption to the highways and to the public.
